OUR LEARNING



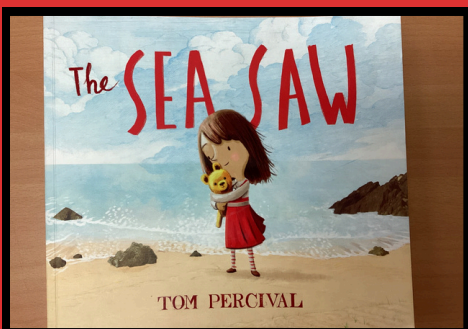
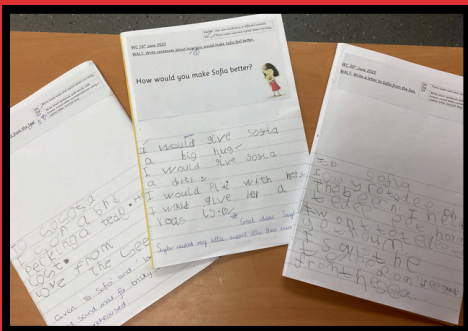
NURSERY

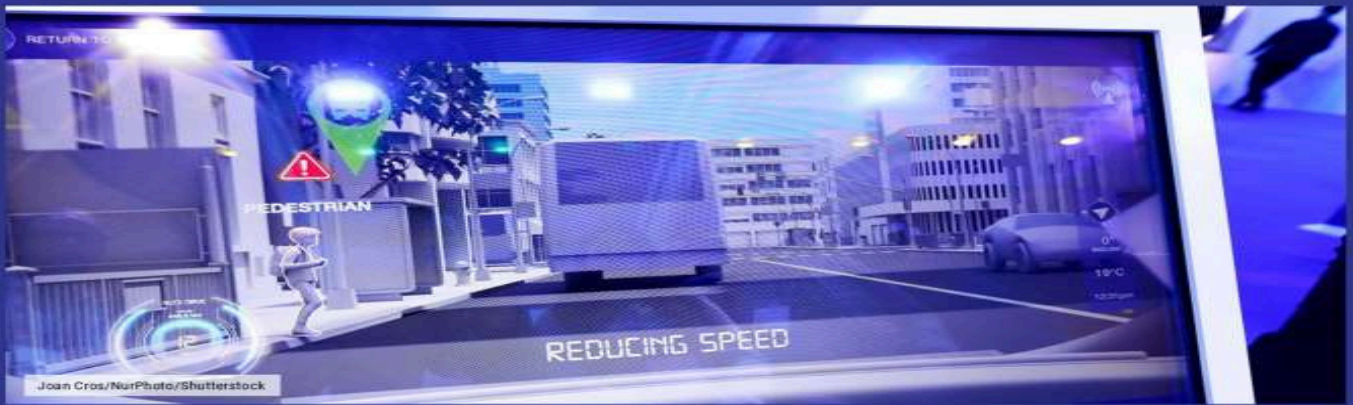
RAINBOW ROOM

Democracy

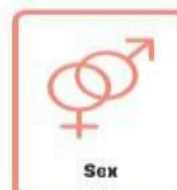
We can all share what we think about driverless cars or anything else that we want to talk about. Everyone deserves to have their ideas and opinions heard.
