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| Autumn | A Season of the year |
| Season | A time of the year, e.g. Spring Summer, Autumn and Winter |
| Natural | Part of nature/ found outside |
| Leaves | Grow on branches of trees. They fall down in Autumn |
| Pine cones | An Autumn fruit, grows on pine trees |
| Acorn | An Autumn fruit, grows on oak trees |
| Rustling | Noise which leaves make |
| Crunchy | Noise that dry leaves make |

Key Knowledge

- To know about natural, Autumn fruits such as pine cones, acorns etc.
- To recognise that leaves fall from trees in Autumn and change colour.
- To talk about some of the things I have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects (linked to Autumn).
- To begin to understand changes which I can see in Autumn.
- To recognise similarities and patterns in the natural environment.
- To understand that we can use our 5 senses to explore Autumn.
