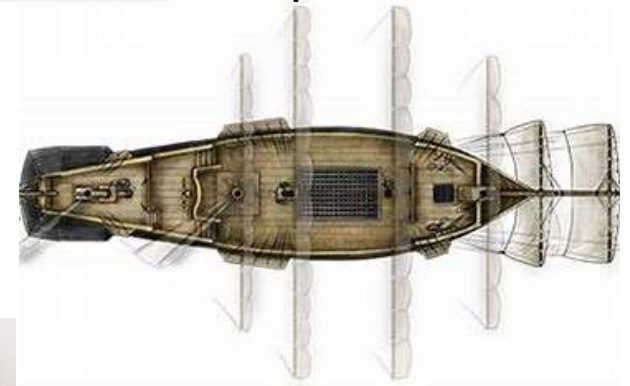

Key Vocabulary	
pirate	A pirate is someone who takes control of a ship and robs it of its treasure.
crew	The people who worked on a ship.
starboard	The right side of the ship (when facing the front of the ship).
port	The left side of the ship (when facing the front of the ship).  A port is also the place a ship would sail to or from to collect crew and goods
Jolly Roger	The famous pirate flag with the skull and crossbones
Hardtack	A biscuit pirates ate that lasted for a long time on their journeys across the sea.
Hammock	A rope bed that pirates would sleep in tied between two posts.
