Key Vocabulary

Fire Breaks- destroying buildings on purpose to make a gap (break) so the fire can't spread.

Bakery - A shop where bread and cakes are made.

Oven- Where food is cooked. Today we use gas or electricity but in 1666 they burnt wood to heat the oven.

Eye Witness- A person who saw an event with their own eyes and can therefore describe it.

Fire Hooks- Giant hooks used to pull houses down.
