### **Message from Mrs Crompton**


One month into the new school year has flown by! All the children are very settled, working hard and enjoying their new learning and experiences across the curriculum. Mrs Hughes has been working on the Personal

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

#### What is asthma?

Asthma is a long term health condition that affects the airways

It affects 1/12 adults and 1/11 children-that is 2-3 children in each class.

For those affected when they come into contact with a trigger, the muscles around their airways become tight and the lining becomes swollen and inflamed narrowing the air passage (imagine diameter of a hose pipe reducing to a straw)

The development of mucus or phlegm further reduces the airway and the persons ability to move air in and out of the lungs, for further information - please use the below QR code to download the app.
