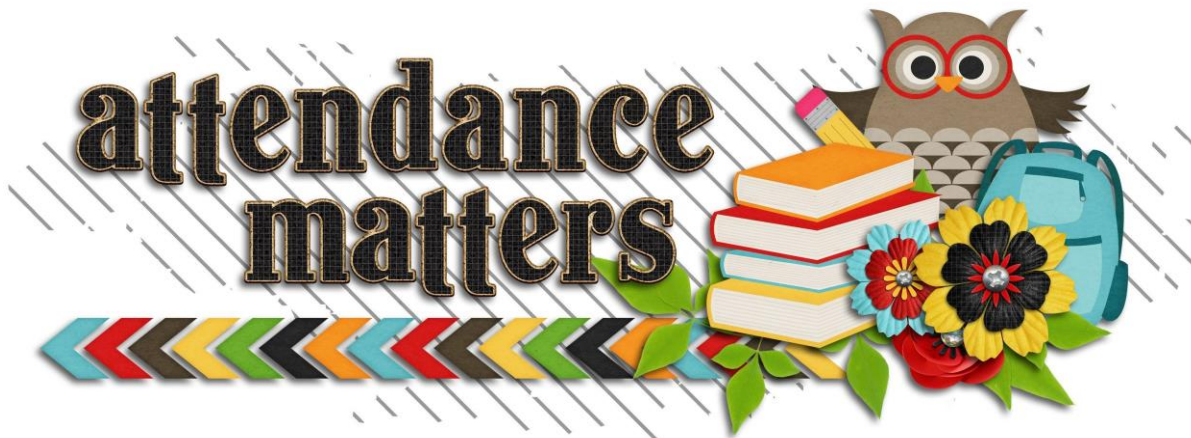

Please note this is a booking service. If you do not book you may be turned away due to stock.

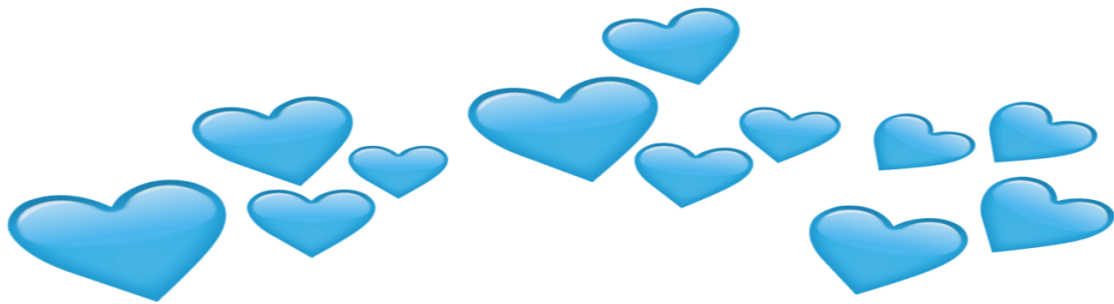

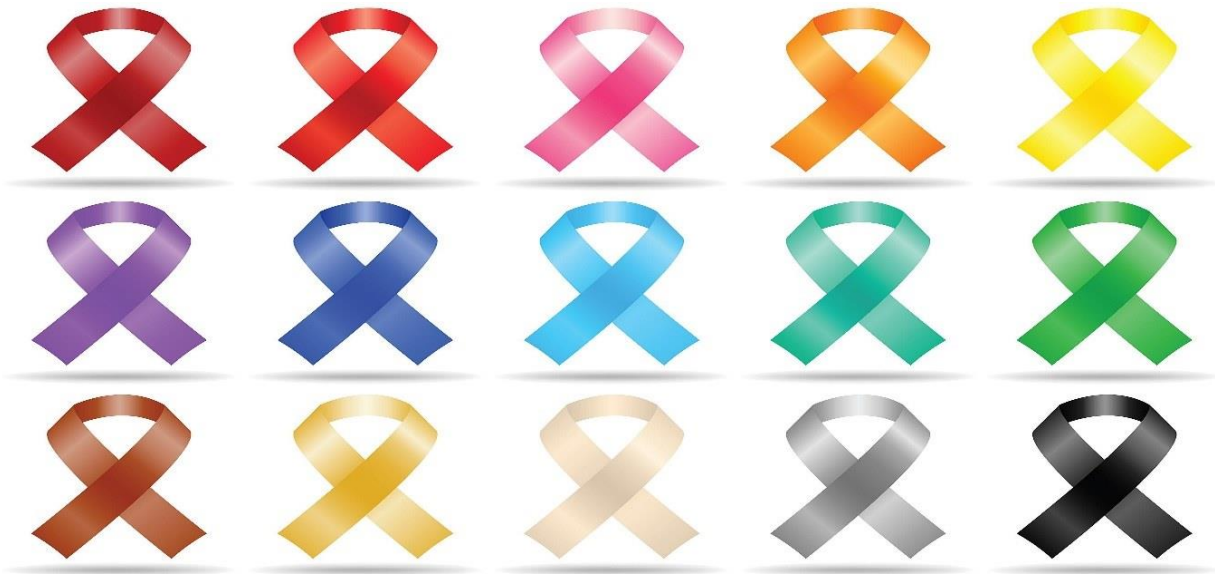
