Sometimes there are age restrictions for online content. This is to ensure everyone can access the internet and feel safe whilst online, no matter their age.



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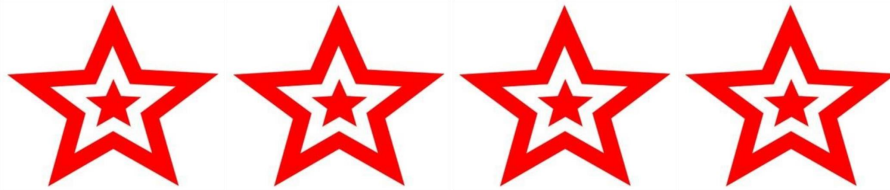
UN Rights of the Child
