OUR LEARNING



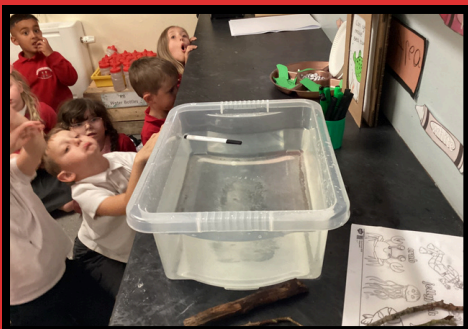
NURSERY

OUR LEARNING

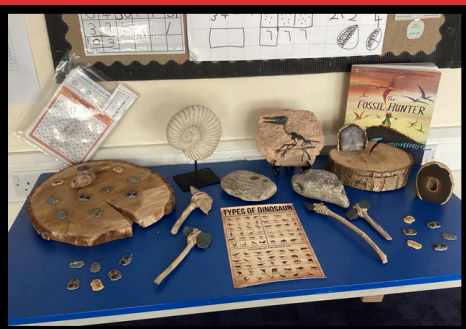


YEAR 1

We looked at a range of fossils and tools to begin our new learning and then made imprints in clay to create our own fossils!

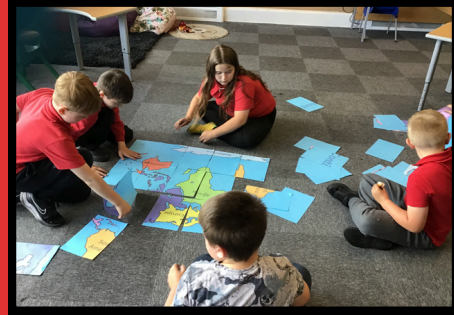
OUR LEARNING

This week in The Bridge, we have mostly been learning about the names of the world's CONTINENTS and we worked together to create a floor map with them all on.

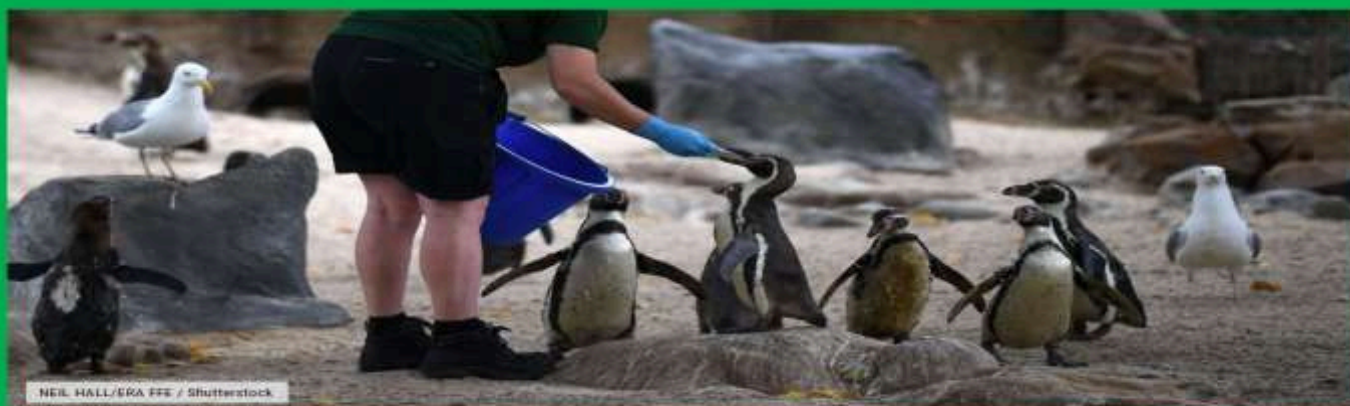
We have also been making our own "Blow Football" games and testing them out to see who was the champion blower!
