## RECEPTION



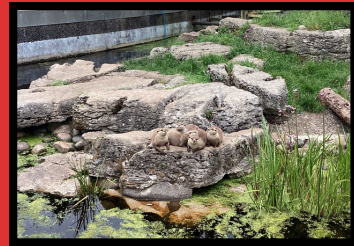

# OUR LEARNING



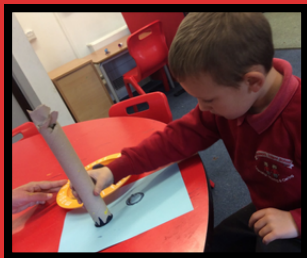
## BRIDGE CENTRE
