






RECEPTION

OUR LEARNING



YEAR 1

Year I really enjoyed learning about change and adapting in Science yesterday. In IH, we discussed how caterpillars create their cocoons to turn into butterflies. In IJ, we looked at changes to our bodies when we get ill and how it adapts creating antibodies that remember- the illness.













Year 2 loved their time experimenting yesterday as part of British Science Week.

2K explored light with the shadow puppets they have been creating and 2H investigated how different types of sugar dissolve in water.

OUR LEARNING



BRIDGE CENTRE

We completed a science experiment using bicarb soda, vinegar and food coloring - we were very excited to watch it explode! We have carried out our daily interventions - PECS, workstations, individual speech and language programmes, Phonics and Attention for Learning.
