Stuart Era	Period of British history that lasted from 1603 to 1714
Catholic	A member of the Roman Catholic Church
Protestant	A member of any of the Western Christian Churches separate from the Roman Catholic Church
Gunpowder Plot	The plan of a group of Catholic men to blow up Parliament and King James I.
Treason	The crime of betraying one's country



Gunpowder Plot Facts



- The Gunpowder Plot happened 5th November 1605.
- 36 barrels of gunpowder were planted under the Houses of Parliament.
- King James 1 was warned about the plot.
- We celebrate the failed plot on 5th November every year.
